A few years after Skipton Building Society was founded, Dr Barnardo travelled to London in 1866 and was so shocked to find children living with no food, no access to education or a roof over their head, that he devoted himself to helping children in the UK.

In the last year, we've provided over £2.2m to help families struggling with the Cost-of-Living (CoL) Crisis; unable to feed their children or provide a warm place to sleep, facing greater hardship as cost spiralled, with no other options available to them.

As the need has increased, Barnardo's has continued to provide emergency funding and housing support to families in desperate need, but we can't keep up with demand alone.

Our work is hugely centred around Skipton's objective of 'helping disadvantaged groups have a home' and we work with a number of Skipton's priority focus groups, including people at risk of homelessness, young care leavers, people with learning disabilities, young carers, people living in areas of high deprivation and people on low income.
